

# 2024 ST. CLEMENT CARNIVAL

## RIDES & TICKETS

All St. Clement students have the option to buy a ride wristband. Full-Day Wristbands can be used all day for all carnival rides. Half-Day wristbands can be used from 4pm to 9pm. Individual ride tickets will also be sold on the day of the carnival.

For those that pre-ordered ride wristbands:

- Students in grades 1 – 8 will receive their wristbands at school on the day of the carnival.
- Students in Preschool and Kindergarten do not have school on carnival day. These students may receive wristbands from their teacher in the cafeteria between noon and 1pm.
- Wristbands and tickets for parish children not enrolled at St. Clement School can be picked up on carnival day at the outside ticket booth.

**Noon to 9pm**

Students in grades 1 - 8 can be dropped off between 10:40 and 11 am (tardy bell at 11 am) and are dismissed at Noon. Students in Preschool and Kindergarten do not have school this day and can join the rest of the students at St. Clement when the carnival opens at Noon.

## VOLUNTEER

The carnival is a success because of you, our parent volunteers. Each school family is asked to sign-up for one hour per child, with a maximum of two hours per family. You have the option to help set up the day before or volunteer on the day of the carnival with indoor games, ticket booths, or hair spray etc. The teachers kindly work the first shift from noon to 1 p.m. Our carnival would not be possible without your time and dedication.

## INSIDE GAMES

Booth tickets can be used for inside games, as well as hair spray, temporary tattoos, free-throw and other contests. Pre-sale booth tickets will be sent home with the oldest child in your family on Friday, May 17th. Additional booth tickets will also be sold on the day of the carnival inside the gym.

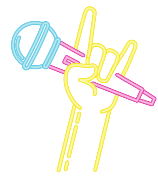
## RAFFLE



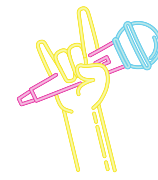
